








Shell Lakes Project






Amy Zone South Drilling 2003




Amy Zone South Cross Section



















Zircon Supply/Demand Outlook to 2010




GDP growth in developed and developing countries





China's urban population





China's shares of world consumption





China's net trade in industrial minerals




Imports or exports expressed as a % of domestic consumption




China's consumption of zircon






World Tile Production - 2002






Zircon price





Polynomial Fit of TiO2 Demand






Polynomial trendline gives Growth = 0.4% at end 2002
