Use of funds


As announced on 3 February 2006, funds raised under the Placement will be applied to further advance the Coburn Mineral Sand Project, fund drilling at the Mount Gunson Copper Project and for general working capital purposes.

Upon completion of this Placement on 7th February 2006 Gunson's share capital will have increased to 82.93 million shares.
